NOTICE OF RACE

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in <u>*The Racing Rules of Sailing*</u> (RRS) and by the current<u>International Optimist Class</u> <u>Rules</u>.
- 1.2 [DP] A condition of entry and participation in this event is the wearing of a U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket or, for international sailors only, a lifejacket approved by their country's corresponding authority, properly secured at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing. All lifejackets must be suitable for the competitor's weight. Wet suits, dry suits, and inflatable lifejackets do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy. These changes are added to RRS 40, and the Preamble to Part 4 does not apply to RRS 40.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix D, Team Racing Rules applies, as modified by the Sailing Instructions (SIs).
- 1.4 US Sailing Prescription RRS 81, Indemnification or Hold Harmless Agreements, does not apply.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be posted by Wednesday, September 18 on the Official Notice Board.

3. COMMUNICATION

The Official Notice Board is the Sanguinetti Dinghy Regatta webpage on the CYC website.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 This event is open to invited teams sailing International Optimist Dinghy class boats. This event has a maximum of twenty (20) teams. Ten (10) teams will be invited. Members of a team do not need to be from the same Yacht Club.
- 4.2 Section 6.1, Eligibility, of the <u>USODA Conditions</u> applies.
- 4.3 To be considered for an invitation, potential teams should contact the Event Chair (contact information in NoR 17) no later than September 1.
- 4.4 Invited teams must accept their invitation by completing online registration at the <u>Sanguinetti Dinghy Regatta</u> webpage no later than September 1, and paying all fees by 0930 on Saturday, September 21.
- 4.5 Each competitor must submit a completed <u>CYC Parental Consent Form and Waiver</u>, signed by a parent or guardian. This form can be scanned and emailed to the Event Chair (contact information in NoR 17) or submitted at Check-in.
- 4.6 Only entries that have completed Check-in by 0930 on Saturday, September 21 are eligible to race. Late Check-in may be allowed only with the approval of the Event Chair.

5. CHECK-IN

- 5.1 Check-in will be on the CYC pool patio between 0830 and 0930 on Saturday, September 21.
- 5.2 Check-in includes completing online registration, paying all fees, and submitting a completed <u>CYC Parental Consent Form and</u> <u>Waiver</u> per NoR 4.5.

6. FEES

The entry fee is \$200 per team (two to three boats per team).

7. EVENT FORMAT

This is an invitational, umpired, Team Racing event with a 2 vs. 2 multiple round robin format. If time permits, mini round-robins and/or knock-out matches among groups of teams may be run. The format will be described further in the SIs and during the Competitor's Briefing.

8. SCHEDULE

9. VENUE

The racing area is inside Marina del Rey Harbor. Parents and friends are encouraged to spectate from the adjacent docks and the CYC Guest Dock.

10. COURSES

The course will be a starboard-hand 'digital N' as described in the SIs.

11. UMPIRING

It is the intention for the regatta to be umpired in accordance with RRS Appendix D, rule D2, as modified by the SIs. Teams may be asked to provide a coach to assist the umpires. This will not be considered a conflict of interest.

12. SCORING

Team Racing Scoring, RRS Appendix D3 and D4 applies.

13. SAFETY [DP]

- 13.1 Each competitor shall have a whistle attached to their PFD at all times while on the water.
- 13.2 Each boat shall have a secure loop in the end of its bow line.
- 13.3 Each skipper who launches their boat from CYC must sign-out prior to leaving the dock and sign-in upon return. Each skipper not launching from CYC, each day, shall notify the Event Chair before leaving their dock and, following the final race of each day, shall notify the Event Chair as soon as practical to confirm they have returned to their dock. (See NoR 17 for Event Chair contact information.)

14. DESIGNATED ADULT

- 14.1 An adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of each competitor. It is solely the responsibility of this adult to decide if the competitor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adult supervising the competitor is ultimately responsible for the risks. Additionally, this designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the event.
- 14.2 Any parent or guardian not personally attending any part of the event shall submit a <u>CYC Parental Consent Form and Waiver</u>, indicating the name and contact information for the adult who shall be on-site, and who is authorized and designated to be responsible for their child during this event per NoR 14.1.

15. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishing teams.

16. RISK STATEMENT

Competitors in the event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. By participating in the event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for the event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in the event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
